Who we are

The Cold Coast Collective is a network, which intends to bring together strong coastal tourism organizations and representatives from European cold-water destinations. Hence, the Cold Coast Collective has a geographical focus on northern Europe.

The network consits of members from different sectors; research insitutiones, municipalities and private organizations, which all have a broad knowledge and a great desire to promote and support the future development of coastal tourism.

The Cold Coast Collective is an informal network primarily based on close relations and tight engagements between the members. The members act within an informal frame and we want to minimize the bureaucracy. In the network we will discuss, connect, and act together on matters related to coastal tourism. In addition, the members of the network are willing to engage themselves in meaningful projects with each other.

We are a non-profit network - an eventual budget will be based on allocated funds and grants. All granted funds will be used to achieve the goals of the network.

Our purpose

The purpose of the network is to:

- Create cooperative relations as a tool for developing ideas, visions and projects together.
- Share knowledge regarding coastal tourism between the members of the network.
- Create a joint voice in order to carry the matter of coastal tourism into the political arena.
- Work towards better funding for coastal tourism in order to secure future development.

Our focus

The members of the network have identified six key working areas:

- Cold-water destinations
- Capacity building
- Digitalization
- Skills development
- Sustainable development
- Development of "the reason to go" experiences

The areas of focus will be clarified at the first official network meeting in the spring 2018 hosted by the Municipality of Varde.

Framework of the network

A focus within the network is strong relations among the members, therefore as a member of the Cold Coast Collective you strive to build strong relations e.g. by travelling back and forth to get to know each other better, developing projects and sharing knowledge.

During the first year, the Municipality of Varde will take the leading role in order to set the frame of the future collaboration of the network. The Municipality of Varde will assume the coordinating role however, we are dependent on help and input from the members.
